LCFS' Wauwatosa clinic has experienced a surge in child mental health services since opening its expansion in July.

So far this year, LCFS has successfully completed a total of 21 infant, stepparent and relative adoptions.

Throughout 2023, LCFS clients of all ages were provided with over 10,000 therapy sessions.

LCFS therapists have been deployed to three community crises since the start of the 2023-24 school year.

- LCFS has 11 outpatient mental health clinic offices located throughout Wisconsin, offering both virtual and in-person sessions. This approach helps us to reach more people while reducing barriers to accessing care.
- Our in-school counselors currently serve 18 different school locations, making it easier for students to receive support when they need it.
